**CATCH OF THE DAY**

Cape Ann Fresh Catch, a Community Supported Fishery based out of Gloucester, MA is in the process of establishing a delivery site in Bolton (Bolton Spring Farm) where local residents would have the opportunity to pick up super fresh, locally caught seafood starting in August. This program provides a unique opportunity for local consumers to reconnect with their local food supply, support local fishermen, and promote sustainable fishing practices. Cape Ann Fresh Catch members sign on for a season of weekly shares, giving the fishing community financial support in advance of their season. In turn, the fishermen provide a regular volume of seafood during the harvesting season to shareholders. Cape Ann Fresh Catch's main mission is to deliver the highest quality, seasonal, sustainably-caught, local seafood. Share offerings for the new season will include both whole fish and fillets—more information on the details of the program can be found at CAFC's website: [www.capeannfreshcatch.org](http://www.capeannfreshcatch.org), where you can also join our mailing list to stay up to date on any new developments. 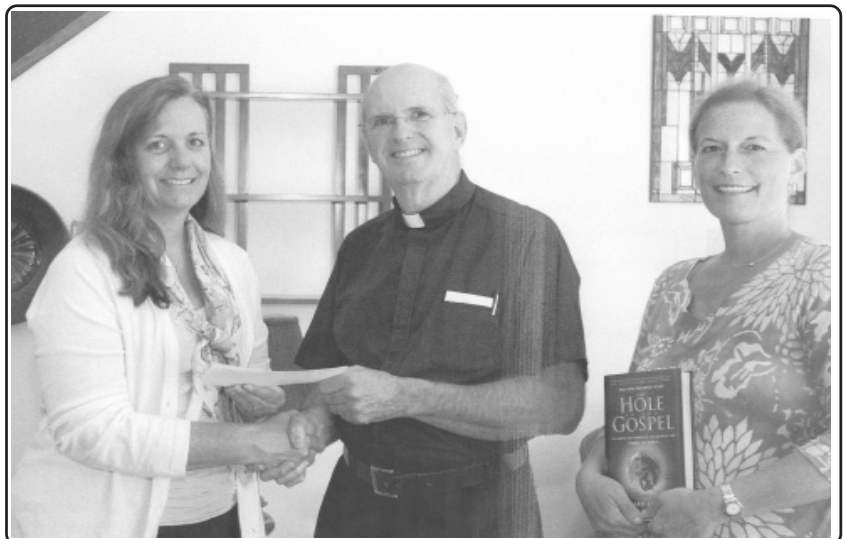


**Well, we did it!**
